

Day :1 Arrival in Cusco & Acclimation Dinner at Morada De los Dioses (June 23)



Upon your arrival on this transforming Plant Medicine Retreat, you will be transferred to your hotel to rest and acclimate, we suggest an noon arrival flight for this day as hotel check in begins at noon. at 3:00pm we will be transferred to Apukuna Tiana where we will have dinner and a special view of amazing scultures.

Day 2: Inti Raymi Festival of the Sun (June 24)



Today is a special day. We have a special activity that happens every 24th of June, on this day, hundreds of musicians gather in the sacred temple of Sacsahuaman, here you will see the people with their traditional ceremonial clothing and the native instruments make their offerings for the Father sun, offering their music and sacred dances to welcome this new time.

Day :3 Qeshwachaka Inca Bridge (UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity) June 25



Our adventure begins at 6:00AM with a comfortable ride and our team that will guide you today from the Sacred Valley to the Inca Bridge providing you with breathtaking views of the Andean landscapes. We will embark on a scenic one-and-a-half-hour van journey to the Combapata viewpoint. Here, we'll be treated to captivating landscapes, witnessing the convergence of the Salcca River with the Vilcanota, the Sacred River of the Incas.

Continuing our adventure, we'll head towards Yanaoca, one of the eight districts in the Canas province of Cusco. From Yanaoca, we'll drive for an additional hour to the Q'ewe district. As we approach, the ancient bridge suspended between steep rock cliffs, nestled in the Apurimac Canyon, will come into view. Leaving the van behind, we'll descend a steep path to a viewpoint for photo opportunities before courageously crossing the bridge together. Brace yourself for an exhilarating experience as you traverse the suspension bridge, taking in the breathtaking view of the river below. On the opposite side, the bridge attendant will welcome us and provide a brief history and construction overview of the bridge. Later, we'll head towards the region housing four famous lakes: Pampamarca, Asnacqoccha, Acopia, and Pomacanchi. Nestled like jewels in the golden-green hills, these lakes glisten in the warm afternoon sun. Native flamingos and other birds grace their edges, creating a picturesque scene. Then, we'll drive to Cusipata. Following lunch, we'll commence our return journey to the Sacred Valley, leaving you with lasting memories of this unique Inca experience.

Day 4: Temple of the Moon Second Wachuma Ceremony June 26



Today you will be picked up around 9 am to head to the temple of the moon where we will have our second Wachuma Ceremony with the Willkasara Medicine Family. Throughout the day, we'll immerse ourselves in chanting, meditating, and dancing in harmony with Mother Nature, Pachamama

Night at: Novotel or similar

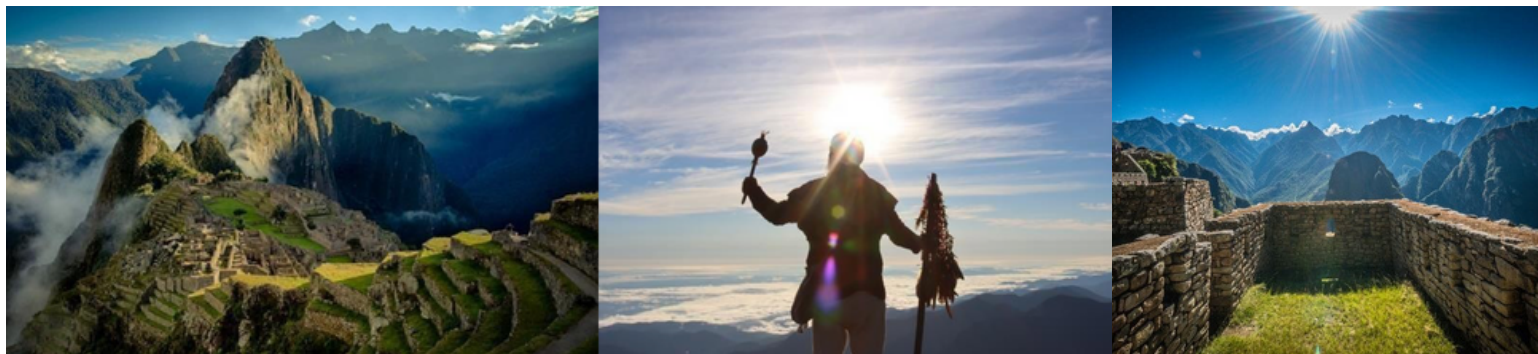
Day 5: Transfer to Aguas Calientes (June 27)



After resting and a light breakfast, we will begin our journey to the town of Aguas Calientes. In Ollantaytambo we will board the Train for a 90 minute train ride to Machu Picchu.

Day 6: Machu Picchu Crystal City of Light - Cusco (June 28)



Today, after breakfast, we begin our journey up to Machupicchu on a 25-minute bus drive that will leave us in the sanctuary. You will be guided by our team through Machu Picchu to show us the most important temples and altars of this sacred land, receiving the messages of the ancient ones. Later in the day we will make our way back to Cusco.

Day 7: Second Wachuma Ceremony at Casa Raiz (June 29)



Today marks our second communion with Grandfather Wachuma. We gather at a sacred retreat center, which serves as the anchor for this profound ceremony aimed at aligning our body, mind, and spirit. This heart-opening ritual offers a unique opportunity to connect with nature and the Divine source.

Throughout the twelve-hour journey of our sacred ceremonies, participants embark on a transformative path. Through unified chants, harmonious dances, and the sharing of profound truths, we activate the sacred medicine within us, guided by ancient ikaros melodies.

Night :Casa Raiz, or Similar

Day 8: Integration and Closing ceremony in Sacsayhuaman (June 30)



Today after breakfast we will head out on a short drive to Sacsayhuaman, great walled complex which means "Decorated head of the Puma," a sacred Inca site. This fortress/temple complex was the ruling palace of the Inca where the living god directed his people. One of the most important religious centers of the Inka's considered the house of the Sun during the Inka's time. Here you will also have time to meditate and explore on your own after our closing and integration with the Willkasara Medicine Family

Day 10: Return home (July 1)

Today after breakfast, you will be transferred to the airport according to your departure times

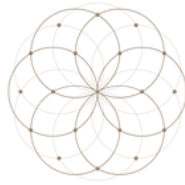
